



Mundesley MUGA - Code of Conduct

We want everyone, of all ages, to be able to enjoy using the MUGA. Please help us look after it so that everyone can continue to enjoy using it in the years to come. These rules are not meant to be onerous or awkward, they are the essential minimum needed to help preserve this very valuable amenity for our Community.

1. Bookings always take priority over open access use
2. Share our MUGA and help others
3. No graffiti or vandalism
4. No bad language and respect local residents
5. No skate boards, bicycle, roller skates etc
6. No food and chewing gum
7. No football boots with steel studs and/or blades
8. No smoking, drugs or alcohol
9. No pets, glass or loud music
10. Participants and spectators must wear suitable footwear
11. Place litter in bins

Please note:

Check MYC web site or Booking board at MUGA for availability of Booking Slots. £2 token is required to operate the floodlights. Lights will automatically turn off at 9pm.

Anyone using the MUGA or surrounding Parish Council facilities do so at their own risk, liability will not be accepted for personal injury or the loss or damage of valuables.

In severe hot or cold weather it may be necessary to close the MUGA to avoid damage to the surface or participants.
